Grief can evoke powerful emotions that leave you feeling like you just can't cope. If you are feeling alone and in need of a good listener, a Hospice Northwest volunteer can help. He or she will meet with you privately, listen without judgement and provide confidential and caring support.

Our "Hearts and Hope Grief Support Group" offers a safe and confidential environment that will allow you to share your thoughts and feelings with others who are also dealing with loss.
