- Indigenous 55+
- Other health care workers

If you are in any of the above priorities have submitted your consent and have not received a vaccine or an appointment for a vaccine on April 8, please call 823-3828 and leave a message, someone will get back to you within 24 hrs.

If you are in the above groups and have not submitted a consent, please do so.

Consents can be found on the North Shore Family Health Team website or can be picked up at J.E. Stokes medical center in Schreiber or the McCausland Hospital in Terrace Bay. They can be submitted to the same locations.

- Remainder of the 70+ population
- Indigenous 40+

If you are included in one of these priorities and submitted a consent before March 30 and have not received a call, please contact 823-3828. If you are in the above priorities and submitted a consent after March 30, we hope to call you this week, but you may have to wait until the next vaccine clinic for an appointment.

Next clinic may include (we still need to confirm this later this week, and need to confirm the date):

- 65–69-year-old
- People over 60 with the identified highest and high-risk health conditions. Please see the document on the North Shore Family Health Team website identifying conditions
- Indigenous 18+

If you are in one of these groups and have not completed a consent, please do so, please write your priority group on the top of the consent so we know where we can fit. We will be identifying health conditions through the Doctors and their Electronic Medical System as well.

Once we have vaccinated the population over 65, the highest-risk health conditions and the high-risk health conditions, we will then be moving onto at-risk health conditions and essential workers, starting with the First Group of Essential Workers as Identified by the MOH. Again, if you feel you fall under one of these groups please complete a consent (directions at the top on how to obtain and where to drop off consents). Please write your health condition or place of employment on the top to help us prioritize you. We still need clarification from the TBDHU to determine where certain types of employment fall on the priority list.
